Executive Committee Roles & Responsibilities

Leadership Team Role & Responsibility

• The Lenawee Cradle to Career Leadership Team is an <u>action</u> body responsible for analyzing data, reviewing trends, legislation and policies to make benchmark recommendations to the Lenawee Cradle to Career Executive Team.
