- Data Collections
 - We still need a lot of updated information.
 - Heather shared the new numbers for the Food Bank. In 2018 the Food Bank distributed 766,560 lbs of food into Lenawee County and in 2019 the distributed 1,076,289 lbs of food.
 - Nancy will reach out to individual agencies and request current data information.
 - Madeline shared Policy Maps with the group and will explore this further. We discussed mapping services, needs and how to identify gaps in service.
