- ▶ Hunger Free Lenawee In May HFL began having Zoom Meetings. Since the Covid Crisis more pantries have started to attend the meetings. United Way and Lenawee Community Foundation have both been active with the group working to ensure the pantry needs are met. UW has assisted with organizing mass donations thru Kellogg's and LCF has assisted with a mass Milk donation. The July meeting will be a Zoom meeting as well. Currently, the pantries indicate that they need Face Masks, cleaning and hygiene supplies and they are struggling with getting meat. In the past they could purchase meat thru the Food Bank at .19 per pound. This is no longer available.
