 - o 294 males and 319 females

- 5 hospitalized
- 309 monitoring at home
- 286 discontinued from isolation and improving
- 13 deaths

- Hospital Council of Northwest Ohio (HNCO) & LHN Leadership met on 09/02/2020 to select questions for the survey tool. The survey is in development.
- Adult & Child surveys will be sent to a randomized list of Lenawee Residents with a \$2 bill as incentive for completion.
 - Data Collection: September – November 2020
 - Data Analysis: December – January 2021
 - Final Draft CHA: March 2021
 - PPT to community – Spring 2021

- Lenawee Medical Examiner Suicide Data – 2019:
 - Suicide was the 3rd highest out of 6 total manners of death reported. (Natural = 193; Accident = 44; Suicide = 16; Homicide = 3.....)
 - Accounted for 6% of total deaths (16 out of 261)
 - Suicide deaths by year -> (2015 = 6; 2016 = 18; 2017 = 5; 2018 = 10; 2019 = 16)
 - Suicides by sex (Male = 13 and Female = 3)
 - Mechanisms of suicide (Firearm = 7; Asphyxia = 5; Drugs = 1; Cut/Stab = 1)

Quality of Life for Older Adults

Region 2 Area Agency on Aging – Martha York provided the following update(s):

- Region 2 has technical assistance and programming to support older adults in utilizing technology. Programming & resources may have abilities to connect older adults to tablets or workshops to improve knowledge on how to utilize technology for improved social connection and resource utilization.
- Working on telemedicine initiatives/programming.

Michigan State University Extension - Vickie Pfeifer provide the following update(s):

- MSU-E is converting their food & nutrition classes to online virtual format. They are interested in collaborations with agencies to connect the community to these offerings. Referral process can be established to link individuals to their programs.
- They have identified that SNAP eligible individuals are communicating challenges in accessing the internet in Lenawee. For individuals experiencing internet access barriers, they have offered a call-in option for people to participate in classes over the phone.

Habitat for Humanity & All About Adrian Resident Coalition - De'Angelo Boone provided the following update(s):

- City of Refuge Ministries continues their program to deliver food to households on the 2nd and 4th Saturday of each month. Individuals residing within the City of Adrian are eligible for food delivery. Residents outside the City of Adrian can access the food available; however, delivery is not available outside of Adrian.
- Fresh produce is available the first Thursday of each month at St. Mary's parking lot.

United Way of Monroe & Lenawee Counties - Laura Pipis provided the following update(s):

- The Health Check event scheduled for October 22 has been cancelled to COVID-19 implications.
- April 22, 2021 is the tentative date scheduled for the next Health Check event, pending COVID-19 implications at that time.

Hospice of Lenawee - Kara Dominique provided the following update(s):

- Working with the Senior Centers to offer drive through blood pressure monitoring.

- HRSA RCORP Planning Grant – WLEN promotion of SUD/ODU initiatives is beginning this month. LSAPC Executive Committee and subgroups will work together to develop messaging to increase awareness of available resources.
- HRSA RCORP Implementation – Frank is scheduling a grant specific meeting with the lead grant coordinators (Prevention, Treatment, and Recovery), ProMedica Grants, and BGSU Evaluation for our first project meeting. Frank is attending a kick-off meeting with HRSA on 09/21/2020.

- Diabetes PATH program has open enrollment in early September and October. The program is offered virtually and there are supports to help individuals and/or caregivers to download the technology needed to participate.

- Hunger Free Lenawee is considering virtual food drives to collect food, goods, and monetary donations. There is consideration of developing a virtual pantry website to help individuals to access food resources in Lenawee.
