2020 Lenawee Community Health Assessment:

- The results of the 2020 Lenawee Community Health Assessment will be ready for LHN review by the end of March 2021. Frank Nagle asked LHN participants if they are in support of scheduling two planning meetings outside of LHN monthly meetings. These meetings will be scheduled for two hours and will focus on:
 - Session 1 – gaps/needs & comparisons to January round table discussion
 - Session 2 – strategies & draft #1 of LHN CHIP for 2021-2023.
- Participants verbalized support. Zero objections or other recommendations were made for the CHIP process.

2020 LHN Participant Survey:

- Key opportunities for improvement in 2020 identified include:

 - Improve the functionality & utilization of the Google Drive
 - Review structure of coalition meetings. Are work groups needed?
