Leadership Updates

COVID-19:

Lenawee County Health Department – Martha Hall shared by Frank Nagle:

- Lenawee County is seeing a significant increase in COVID-19 cases. If the current trend continues, we will exceed numbers seen during the Winter peak. Variants have been identified in Lenawee County COVID cases; some of which are associated with increased transmissibility. COVID-19 hospitalizations are also increasing. It is crucial that we all do our part to prevent the spread of the virus in our community:
 - o Practice the 3 W's:
 - Wash your hands frequently
 - Watch your distance from others not in your household
 - Wear a mask
 - o Consider limiting the number of people you are around when possible – keep your bubble small.
- If planning to travel, get tested 1-3 days before your trip, and 3-5 days once you return. See Michigan Department of Health and Human Services Travel Safety Guidance https://www.michigan.gov/documents/coronavirus/Accessible_Safe_Holiday_Travel_Guidance_2222021_FINAL_717620_7.pdf
- Isolate from others if you have symptoms (do not assume it is allergies)

2020 Lenawee Community Health Assessment:

- LHN reviewed a presentation of the 2020 Lenawee CHA. Key observations & feedback include:
 - o Request to add scales for BMI & binge drinking with their data points in the assessment & presentation.
 - o Percentage of adults uninsured significantly increased from 8% to 18%.
 - o Request to add 2020 to the Total on bar graphs showing data across ages & across assessments.
 - o Great data is available for oral health & dental. Opportunity to partner with dental groups.
 - o Request for participants to review data & if age or demographic breakdowns for particular questions is wanted, we can request from Hospital Council.
 - o Question if Child data excludes adult parent respondents under the age of 30 because of lack of surveys or if that was specifically for adult data.
 - o MiPHY data has been challenging for schools to collect due to COVID. Need to consider our secondary & other data sources to confirm needs of youth.
