- As of 07/01/2021, Lenawee County has 9,392 positive cases:
 - o 4356 males and 5036 females
 - o 0 hospitalized
 - o 6 monitoring at home
 - o 9215 discontinued from isolation and improving
 - o 171 deaths
 - o 44.7% fully vaccinated
 - o 47.4% at least 1 dose
 - o 70% is vaccination rate goal

- Catholic Charities is expanding trauma services with a trauma assessment center on Erie street by St. Mary's Church in Adrian. They have partnered with Sprouts for physical and occupational therapy and have a pediatric doctor partner. The center anticipates opening in the next few weeks.

Michigan State University Extension – Vicky Pfeifer provided the following update(s):

- Vicky recognized Martha York and the Region 2 Area Agency on Aging team for their innovative programming providing older adults with tablets, access to technology/internet, and to food boxes. The result of their work is that older adults are able to connect to MSU-E education in a time when they are very isolated.
- Older adults receive a food delivery that coincides with the MSU-E education allowing them to have a more interactive and hands-on virtual education experience.

Family Medical Center of Michigan – Audrey Smith provided the following update(s):

- Family Medical Center continues to offer adult COVID-19 vaccines.
- They have also started providing Pfizer vaccine for youth ages 12 – 15 years old. Individuals can schedule appointments, call ahead, or walk-in to receive the vaccine.

- disAbility Connections has a program to connect individuals with disability to a tablet and internet if they do not have access.
