Wraparound is a highly individualized planning process to help keep families intact and functioning together. It promotes building community-based options that effectively support and serve children who are at risk for out of home placement.

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How do I get started with Wraparound?

If this process is something you are interested in, speak to your worker or community partner about your interest in Wraparound planning. From there, your case will be presented to the Community Advisory Team by the Wraparound Facilitator.

There is an acceptance/non acceptance screening. Families will be notified of the decision either way.

Wraparound eligibility below:

- A child/youth who is under 18 years old and is a resident of Lenawee County
- Child/youth and family involved with several different community agencies
- Child/youth at risk of being placed or already placed outside of the home

Model of Fidelity

As we learn the needs and dreams of your family, we will develop goals. Goals will continuously be tracked and modified throughout the Wraparound process. If something isn't working, we'll go back to the drawing board to find something that does work!

10 Principals of Wraparound:

- 1) Family Voice & Choice
- 2) Individualized
- 3) Strength-Based
- 4) Natural Supports
- 5) Collaboration
- 6) Unconditional Care
- 7) Community-Based
- 8) Culturally Competent
- 9) Team Based
- 10) Outcome Based

Following the 10 Principals, your Wraparound Facilitator will begin by identifying what the overarching goal and vision for your family is. Each Wraparound Plan is created with your family in the driver's seat. What do you want to gain? What would make your family thrive? From there, we will dive deep into Wraparound Planning. The goal is to graduate from Wraparound so your family has the tools needed to soar!



Who makes up the teams?

Child and Family Team (CFT):

 A team of your natural supports; neighbors, close relatives, friends, your child's teacher, coach, anyone who supports your family

Community Advisory Team (CAT)

 A team of representatives from child serving organizations, involving personnel the school, court, local non-profits, or whoever has a strong connection to resources available to support your family

Finance/Executive Team (ET):

 A team who oversees the policies and procedures of Wraparound

Your Wraparound Facilitator is the liaison for each of the teams above. They will work to get your family what you need to reach your goals.

These are teams designed to support you and your family!
