Strategic Planning

- A small group will meet next Wednesday May 31st from 8-12 at Old National. After the small group meets the larger group will reconvene and the results will be presented at the legislative dinner on June 29th.
- Marty reported that the county is in the process of putting fixed allocation back on the ballot in November. They are looking at services and what people want based on the visioning sessions. It is important that this gets proper publicity.
- The focus groups need to be inclusive of members from all parts of the county. (ex. Morenci was only concerned with Morenci). We need to get people to think they are from Lenawee, not just one city/town in the county.
- There was a question as to an anticipated target date for completion of this project. Eric should be able to help us determine this. (A date of October 15th was put on the table)
- It was suggested that maybe graduate students at the colleges could assist. The Dean of Students at Siena would be a good starting point.

Strand Reports:

- Lenawee Health Network ProMedica has been meeting with other community leaders to work on how to fill the gaps in the community with the closure of the in-patient mental health unit in Tecumseh.
- Arts & Culture A lot is going on at Manitou Beach with trying to turn that area into an artist's village. A countywide art tour is planned to take place in October. This group is also trying to involve the Croswell, TCA, and the Adrian Symphony.

- Connecting Lenawee Hubfest is June 10th. The League of Michigan Bicyclists will be hosting this one day event in Adrian with various distance rides. It was suggested that they add signage on the Kiwanis Trail designating where you are. The group is in need of a video to assist with fundraising efforts.
- Chris reported Lap Plus Creative is working on a master plan with city officials. Some issues they identified dealt with signage and other things for the Kiwanis Trail. They also can assist with funding in connecting downtown Adrian and Tecumseh.
- Chris talked with Kelly Heidbreder at the Tech Center to work on the video. Regarding the easement piece-3 to 4 private landowner meetings are in process.
- Tim reported a Wyndham Hotel is being built across from Adrian College in the Adrian Industrial Park. A major manufacturer is looking at Adrian.
- Cradle to Career they are interviewing for Ann's replacement to fill the C2C piece. Tecumseh is moving ahead with customized learning. Many things are going on this summer regarding reading by third grade.
